Ron Ego, Born in Weston, Ontario, youngest of 5, three brothers and a sister. As a child I lived in Mount Dennis (just a little south of Weston). After high school I worked for Toronto Hydro in Collections then at the age of 23 he signed with the NHL as an on-ice official and later as supervisor of Officials A short time after marriage to Faye Hancock they moved to Brampton, where they lived for 35 years and raised their three children, Michelle, Michael and Collette.

During those years and in between time on the ice he

owned and operated for a very successful trophy and awards business: with two of his many clients being the Toronto Blue Jays and Labatt's Breweries.

Ron has always been very involved in community life, such as in Brampton: President of Flower City Kiwanis, Chair of the Salvation Army Red Shield Appeal and organizing a NHL Officials Golf Tournament which raised thousands of dollars for the Salvation Army.

Ron and Faye and their children vacationed in Wasaga Beach for many years, purchased a cottage in 2000 and moved here permanently in 2006.

Ron, served here as a Town Councillor from 2014 – 2018.

He was Supervisor of Officials in the National Hockey League from 1991 – 2004.

He trained and developed new Officials throughout North America. Liaised with Team executives, General Managers and Coaches regarding disputes. He did many media appearances.

Flag Raising - Probus Month - Wasaga Beach










